ATTENTION International Students- Graduate students for whom English is not the first language must certify their proficiency in spoken English before assuming Graduate Teaching Associate (GTA) duties. You may become certified through the following scores:

- TOEFL iBT Speaking component score of 28 or higher
- IELTS Speaking score of 8.5 or higher
- *Oral Proficiency Assessment (OPA) score of 4.0 or higher

The OPA is a test administered by the ESL Spoken English Program at OSU, which determines a student's level of oral proficiency. More information can be found on the following website:
